French courses for exchange students

Free French courses only before the start of each semester and before the beginning of your courses at the Faculties, or free extensive French courses 2h/week during the 1st and 2nd semester, for Erasmus+ student only, and only if the number of participants is sufficient. Visa requirement for non-European students

Since April 17, 2021, international students can apply for an online visa on France-Visas. The new service is accessible to students applying for a long stay visa living in a country where visa application is outsourced and available online : <https://www.campusfrance.org/en/student-visa-for-france-login-to-france-visas>. The French social security registration process for foreign students

Since May 2019, every non-European student have to register at the French Social Security System. You'll have to do that on-line, before or after your arrival in Toulouse: <https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/>

You need to anticipate if you do that after your arrival, and prepare the following documents for this on-line registration:

- Proof of registration for the current academic year (Certificate of registration at an accredited institution, or your student card)
- Proof of identity (A valid identity document or passport)
- A Student visa ("visa étudiant")
- A vital record (A long copy of your birth certificate, a birth certificate showing your parents' information, an updated family record book ("livret de famille," a certificate of marriage, or any other document issued by a consulate (original birth certificate, individual vital record, etc.) authenticated by a legible stamp.)
- A residency permit ("titre de séjour")
- An official banking information slip ("RIB") in your name (Your "Relevé d'Identité Bancaire"/ RIB contains your exact banking information. Your health care reimbursements will be paid directly into your designated account.)

Accommodation

- **Full academic year/Autumn (1st) semester** : ask before the 1st of July for September - Attributions in July
- **Spring (2nd) semester** : ask before the 30th November - Attributions in December
