The Diplôme Universitaire d'Études Françaises (DUEF) of the Institut Universitaire de langue et culture françaises IULCF of the Institut Catholique de Toulouse ICT is an intensive six-month (validation of 30 ECTS) and annual (validation of 60 ECTS) French language learning programme covering the 5 levels (A1 to C1) of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). The aim of this course is to acquire skills in the French language and culture in order to pursue university studies without having to take a language certificate.

## Public

Applicants must

- have a baccalauréat or equivalent diploma
- be non-French-speaking

## Organisation

- Semester 1: 7 September - 18 December 2026
- Semester 2: 4 January - 30 April 2027

Enrolment by semester or year.

Each level is prepared and validated in 1 semester:

- Levels A1 to B1: 216 hours of lessons over 12 weeks / semester
- Levels B2 and C1: 240 hours of lessons over 12 weeks / semester

## *Learning objectives*

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### **On completion of this course, you will be able to :**

#### At A1 level :

- Understand a clear, simple message relating to everyday life and locate simple information.
- Understand information in very simple everyday documents.
- Respond to simple requests for personal information.
- Give information about their activities.
- Recount an experience, an event, etc.
- Talk about yourself, your family and your immediate environment. Answer simple questions.

#### At A2 level :

- Understand a clear, simple message on familiar topics.
- Understand the main points of a simple story or personal letter.
- Identify one or more precise or predictable items of information in a simple document related to everyday situations.
- Write a short, organised story in the past tense.
- Present information or a request related to everyday life in an organised way (regular or informal formal letter, email).
- Talk about yourself and describe your immediate environment and your impressions of it.
- Answer questions and make requests.
- Ask for simple information in predictable situations.

### At B1 level:

- Understand the main ideas and/or main and secondary events on familiar or topical subjects in clear standard French.
- Understand one or two texts in general and in detail, including the cultural dimension.
- Gather significant information, understand common expressions, infer meaning and identify conclusions and opinions.
- Understand texts in everyday professional, public and educational language.
- Comment on developments, compare data.
- Reformulate main ideas in a coherent text.
- Express him/herself in writing by relating facts in terms of their anteriority, simultaneity and/or posteriority.
- Describe people, places, objects, states, situations...
- Formulate an assessment, a judgement, an explanation, a justification...
- Produce a simple, constructed and coherent speech to express opinions and feelings on familiar or topical subjects.
- Answer and react to requests from an interlocutor.

### At B2 level :

- Understand an authentic document.
- Reconstruct the content of a conference-type document.
- Understand the nature of one or more documents, their content and the author's communicative intention.
- Understand one or more documents in general and in detail.
- Express yourself in writing on social and general culture topics.
- Express his/her point of view accurately and in a reasoned way.
- Describe events in detail.
- Familiarise yourself with academic writing.
- Explain and develop clearly in a constructed manner an argued point of view on a wide range of concrete or abstract topics.

### At C1 level:

- Understand a long authentic spoken document and report on it by taking notes.
- Understand an authentic written document of an argumentative nature in order to answer a questionnaire and/or report on it.
- Develop a structured, well-argued personal position in an academic essay.
- Present a theme developed in a dossier.
